Excluding the portfolio, the written elements of the third year accrue 90 CP.</p> <p>5.2 Project Report (RP2) from Final Year BVetMed or BVSc* OR Hypothesis Driven 30 CP Research Project of between 3000 - 4000 words and 15-minute oral presentation.</p> <p><i>*Applies to projects completed during Final Year in 2012 or later.</i></p>
